



## **514 POLICY – Alcoholic Beverages**

### **514.1 Statement of Policy**

The possession, serving and consumption of alcoholic beverages on Redlands Community College premises is prohibited, except that at specific designated events, Redlands Community College may allow alcoholic beverages to be sold, served, and consumed within designated areas of the Darlington Chapel and grounds within 100 yards surrounding the Chapel.

## **514 PROCEDURE – Alcoholic Beverages**

### **514.1:1 Definitions of Alcoholic Beverage**

For the purposes of this policy, “Alcoholic Beverage” is defined as beer (as defined in 37 O.S. § 306(5)), wine, and sparkling wine.

### **514.1:2 Sale of and Service of Alcoholic Beverages**

The sale, service, or consumption of alcoholic beverages shall not be permitted at any event for which students are the primary intended audience or attendees. The President or his designee shall designate those events at which alcoholic beverages may be sold, served and consumed. Neither Redlands Community College nor persons acting in their capacity as employees of the College shall sell or serve alcoholic beverages pursuant to this procedure.

- A. All alcoholic beverages will be sold and/or served by an appropriately licensed third-party vendor. No Redlands Community College funds will be spent for the purchase of alcoholic beverages or services.
- B. The vendor is solely responsible for the sale and serving of alcoholic beverages.
- C. The vendor is solely responsible for strict compliance with and enforcement of all local, state, and federal laws and regulations applicable to the sale of alcoholic beverages.
- D. All vendors providing alcohol for an event that takes place on the Redlands Community College campus must provide evidence of commercial general liability insurance coverage in the amount \$1,000,000 naming Redlands Community College as an additional insured on the vendor's insurance policy.

### **514.1:3 Area of Sale and Consumption**

Alcoholic beverages may be sold, served and/or consumed only in those areas of the Darlington Chapel as identified in section 514.1 designated by Redlands Community College. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages other than those sold and/or served pursuant to 514.3 of this policy is prohibited on Redlands Community College premises, including at Darlington Chapel and the surrounding grounds. Nothing in this procedure shall be construed to permit the sale, service or consumption of alcoholic beverages at any other location owned or controlled by Redlands Community College.
